I'm a psycho but it's okay

A drama that caught my eye because it was a full-fledged Kim Soo-hyun comeback work. Nevertheless, it was a drama that was not watched live. Unlike other dramas, [Psycho But It's Okay], which has only just finished running on Netflix, is a work that surprisingly was not easy to get rid of. It's a story that there wasn't much excitement in terms of immersion or fun, but I think that's why the ratings were also disappointing. We have high expectations for Kim Soo-hyun, so I wonder if our trust in him was too strong. In that sense, I also wondered how much pressure was put on the comeback work. The drama [Psycho But It's Okay] still has three or four memorable keywords. I would like to briefly review the drama through that keyword.



Keyword 1. Strange and beautiful romance

Before and even watching the drama [Psycho But It's Okay], I felt that the lineup of actresses who were the subject of romance with Kim Soo-hyun was a little weak compared to Kim Soo-hyun. If you talk about actors like Seo Ye-ji and Park Gyu-young as their representative work! And status and strength. Oh Jeong-se also appeared as an older brother.

I think that's why it was said that this drama was mysterious. The character of Go Go-young, played by Seo Ye-ji, is very unique than expected, and Seo Ye-ji is very good at it. The barrier to entry is a bit difficult, but once you gain a sense of speed, I think [Psycho But It's Okay] is not a drama that has many elements that you will be surprised by and enjoy. Autism Spectrum Disorder

Autism spectrum disorder is a type of developmental disorder that is a type of neurodevelopmental disorder that refers to brain development or growth disorders . Previously, under the developmental disability category, five types of disorders were divided into five categories: autistic disorder, Asperger's disorder, and pervasive developmental disorder not otherwise specified. However, recently , it is difficult to see it as an independent disorder, and it has been revised as Autism Spectrum Disorder because there are differences in the manifestations depending on the severity of autism or the degree of intellectual and psychosocial development- !

Characteristics of Autism Spectrum Disorder include limited and repetitive behaviors, and difficulty making eye contact or communicating and interacting. Symptoms usually appear before the age of 3 years, and a typical symptom is a lack of interest in parental interaction.

There is no known exact cause of Autism Spectrum Disorder . In the medical community, it is thought that various causes such as genetic causes (genetic defects or mutations, family history), neurobiological causes, social brain defects, and cerebral connectivity problems will act in a complex way .

Disability etiquette in daily life, when conversing with people with autism , use honorifics appropriate to the age of your life so that you do not unconditionally speak vulgarly or treat them as young people ! Also, choose concise and clear words, clarify their pronunciation and, if necessary, add pictures, gestures, etc. to aid understanding . Lastly, listen carefully to the end of what you are saying and understand exactly what you want to express in the situation and in the sentence ! :D

"It's natural for disabled actor Lee Ah-gi to do this... There are parts that cannot be imitated."

"I was taught sign language. I was worried a lot, but surprisingly it fit well and was interesting. The sign language in the movie was mastered in the first class, and after that, I tried to make it look a little more real."

Actor Jin Ki-joo, who played the deaf Kyung-mi in the tea-bing movie 'Midnight', which was released in June, was the first to learn sign language for the character. With professional help, I tried to look like a 'real' deaf person using oral language.

In the movie 'Stone', which was released last year, Kim Dae-myung played the character Seok-gu with a developmental disability. In an interview, he explained the acting process by meeting and talking with a teacher at a facility in Boramae Park and understanding Seok-gu.

In the currently airing tvN drama 'Mt. Jirisan', Seo Yi-gang (Jeon Ji-hyun), who was paralyzed by a distress accident, is appearing in a wheelchair. tools have been expressed. KBS2's 'Drama Special-F20' took the subject of schizophrenia, and in the tvN drama 'Psycho, but it's okay', which aired last year, a character suffering from high-functioning autism with the autism spectrum and developmental disability level 3 appeared.

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According to the '2020 Statistics of the Disabled at a Glance' provided by the Korea Employment Agency for the Disabled, the number of registered disabled people in Korea is 2.61 million. It accounts for 5.05% of the total population. Although the proportion of the disabled in TV dramas and movies is not high compared to this ratio, recently efforts are being made to illuminate the socially underprivileged characters in various ways, and the appearance of the disabled is becoming more natural.

There are also concerns about expression. At one time, it was pointed out that people with disabilities were tragically drawn or used as instrumental characters, but now characters with disabilities are active as the main characters and are expressed as attractive characters. PD Park Shin-woo, who directed 'Psycho But It's Okay', said about the character Moon Sang-tae, who has an autism spectrum, "There have been many expressions of disappointment or regret for a character like the state. This time, I wanted people to feel good and happy when they see the condition, and to feel a lot of attraction to the condition."

Nevertheless, limitations still exist. Even if there was no intention of being demeaning, erroneous expressions or descriptions caused by not fully understanding the position of people with disabilities are often appearing. 'Psycho But It's Okay', which accompanied efforts to improve awareness of the autism spectrum, was also embroiled in derogatory controversies. In the drama, towards Moon Sang-tae, he said, "I think the back of my hair is sensitive. Is that the erogenous zone?"; "Ah bomb switch. It explodes when touched, doesn't it?" was criticized for writing the line.

'Drama Special-F20' was criticized for hastily used schizophrenia as a material. Regarding this work, which tells the story of Ae-ran, a mother who wants to hide her son's schizophrenia, the people with schizophrenia and other disabled people's groups said, "The director shows his prejudice and fear of disgust towards a schizophrenic patient he has never met. Violating someone's human rights with unconfirmed facts is a tyranny in the name of 'creation.'" This is an error that occurred by excluding the voices of people with disabilities while dealing with the stories of people with disabilities. It deals with various disabilities and introduces disabled characters, but in reality, disabled people are being erased.

Recently, a movement of change has been detected centering on Hollywood. In the Marvel movie 'The Eternals', women, people of color, children, sexual minorities, and the hearing-impaired were active as heroes, and among them, the deaf hero was played by an actual deaf actor. In August of last year, in the movie 'Coda', real deaf actors played all the roles of the deaf.

Hollywood's movement to pursue diversity over the years has extended beyond the subject matter and expression to the actors who play it. In order to reduce errors in expression and expand the diversity pursued by the media, there was a realization that an open perspective on the characters and materials as well as the actors was needed.

Director Han Kyung-hoon of 'Accompanying: A Life's Excursion', a play to improve awareness of the disabled, played together by six disabled actors and seven non-disabled actors, said, "I thought it was natural for the voices of people with disabilities to be included in the stories of people with disabilities. "No matter how veteran actors act, there are parts that cannot be imitated," he said.

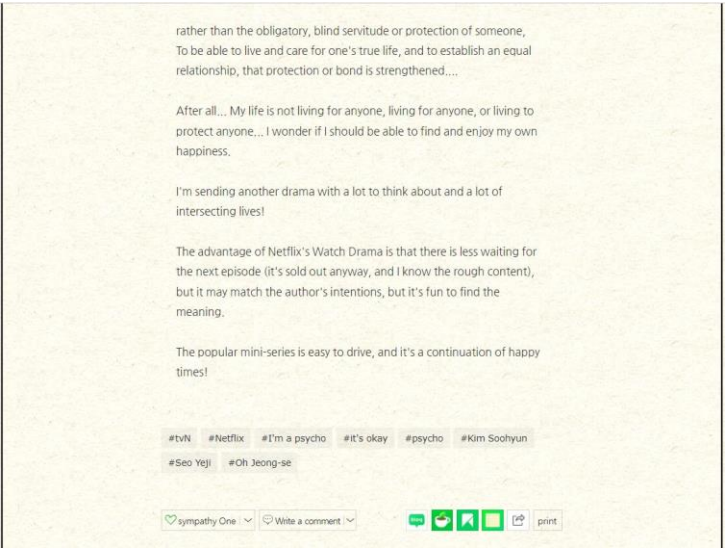
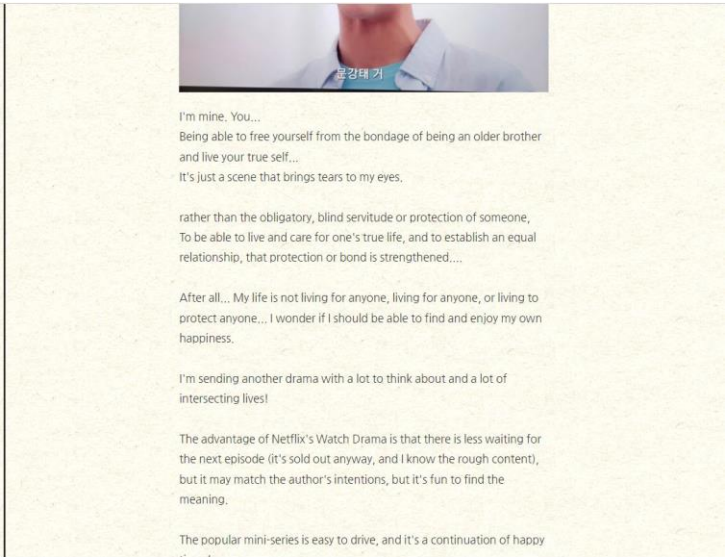


A person who neglects and neglects is worse.

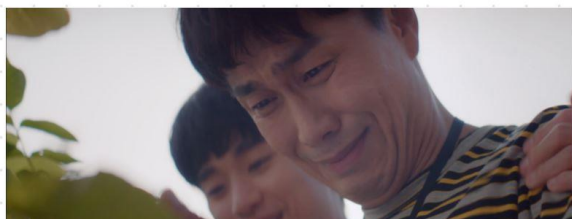
The last chapter "In Search of the Real Real Face"

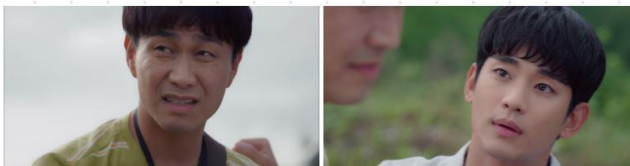

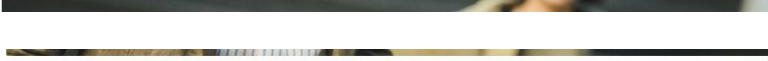

Courage to Face Trauma: Why 'I'm Psycho But It's Okay' is a Good Drama

The drama 'Psycho But It's Okay' has ended. 'Netflix' ranked 6th in the global overall, recording the highest ranking for a Korean drama. The content was as good as the topic. He communicated with viewers while having the fun of 'Cooking Rice Cake', and gave comfort to many people in line with the plan's intention of a 'healing human drama'. The acting skills of the actors were also solid. I went to see actress Kim Soo-hyun, and I fell in love with actress Seo Ye-ji, who met the character of her life, and rediscovered actress Oh Jeong-se, who played an autism spectrum disorder.

The reason why <Psycho But It's Okay> is a good drama is that it allows viewers to project their trauma onto the characters and look at them. Most of us had problems in the process of forming attachment relationships with our parents when we were

The drama throws the message "It's okay" by looking at this weakness that everyone has, rather than dividing it into the dichotomy of 'normal' and 'abnormal'.

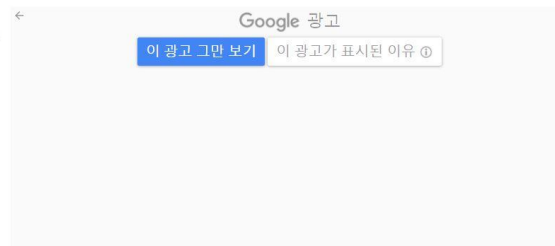

By focusing and illuminating the trauma of one character in each painting, it calmly shows why such trauma occurred. It's not just about looking at the cause. It contains the figure of the character overcoming the trauma little by little. The good thing about the drama is that the process of overcoming trauma is a way of getting help from people around you.

It is true that you need your own courage and will to overcome it, but it was heard as a message that someone next to you must reach out a hand to take the first step. It was impressive to see how they helped each other out in the world. Although the background of the drama was set as a mental hospital, the hospital was also seen as a microcosm of our society where various people live in harmony. It depicts how we live while acknowledging each other's shortcomings and filling them in.



In this drama, the expression 'leash' is used as a metaphor for the cause of trauma.

In this drama, the expression 'leash' is used as a metaphor for the cause of trauma. In the play, there is a fairy tale called 'Dog in Springtime', and although the dog in the fairy tale is able to run away freely by loosening its leash, it cannot break its leash. The reason it is not easy to break the leash is that it takes 'courage' to break it.

The message that 'courage' is important appears in the second scene in which Kang Tae teaches Moon Myeong the 'how to hug a butterfly'. To Kang Tae's advice that he counts to three when he can't control himself, Moon Young says, "You have to face trauma like this from the front, not the back." We felt sorry for those who lacked the courage to face trauma in front of us, and we felt catharsis when we saw the courage of an unexpected person. The facial expressions of the characters who broke their leash and became free are still in my memory.

Not only in dramas but also in reality, too many people struggle with forming a wrong attachment relationship with their parents when they were young. The main character, Go Won-young, is a character who has a hard time reading other people's emotions because of her mother, who tried to raise her children according to her own taste. Although he looks strong on the outside, he has a defensive inner side that tries to hide his weakness with fancy clothes such as armor. This is because, when he was young, he pretended to be a strong person because he was obsessed with listening to his mother.

Inside those who pretend to be 'strong', there is a defense mechanism that is afraid of revealing their weak side. Moon-young, who could not cut her hair because her mother said that she had long hair, cuts her hair with her own hands and cuts the leash. I thought that Moonyoung wasn't as weak in this scene. He received help from Kang Tae, but it was because he was independent and independent.



Guardian Moon Kang-tae is also accustomed to not revealing herself because her mother always took care of her older brother with autism spectrum when he was

mother always took care of her older brother with autism spectrum when he was young. He is a character who does not know how to say what he likes or wants, and does not express it even when it is difficult. We often have friends like Kangtae around us. Those friends who are not good at rejecting because of the 'good person complex' and only try to fit in with others.

Moonyoung sometimes calls "a hypocrite" about Kang-tae's appearance, but in reality, Kang-tae has continued to live in such a state that he is good on the outside and rotten on the inside. Kang Tae, who lacked the courage to be hated, meets Moon Young and gradually finds happiness by escaping from the 'joker smile'.

He is also the person who has changed the most positively. It seems that personality traits with clear likes and dislikes played a role in bringing about positive changes.

He hates noise, touch, filth, violence and lies. My favorites are painting, dinosaurs, Ko Gil-dong, striped shirts, and writer Koh Young-yong. A person who knows exactly what he likes and dislikes like this is likely to change into a positive one, even if it seems that he lacks something right away.



At Kangtae's request to accept Moonyoung as his younger brother, he turns away and says, "Go Moonyoung, won't you come soon?" Or cut pork cutlets and give Kangtae pocket money saying, "Use it sparingly." and slamming Do Hee-jae on the back of the head. In particular, in the last episode, the figure of independence as an illustrator was drawn and moved. The changed appearance of this state would have given viewers the courage to live their lives.

Adam, who was the son of a member of the National Assembly and played an acute manic patient who enjoys exposure, was also impressed. He was born as the youngest son of a good family, unable to study, and is a character who has not received proper attention once and has become a fool. I keep exposing myself because I want to get attention. Children need appropriate attention from adults in order to feel self-efficacy, but I often see children who are crooked because they are not recognized by their parents because they cannot study. Adam is fortunate to be able to play a game and heal his trauma with the help of Moonyoung, but many children in reality still go through a difficult teenage period.

Yoo Seon-hae, who has dissociative personality disorder due to the memory of being abandoned by his parents, also suffers from domestic violence as a child, but with Kang-tae's help, he confesses his wounds to his father and is recovering from the trauma. There was a directing in which the actor's appearance was changed to a child, and even now, it was read as a message that we should pay attention to children who will be abused somewhere.



On the other hand, trauma is not only caused by the formation of relationships with parents. It occurs in a variety of situations, such as experiencing incidents and accidents. I was impressed that this drama deals with the trauma of war. The younger generation who have not experienced war are unaware of the horrors of war, and this drama shows how trauma can be revived by dealing with post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD) through a liver failure patient.

The scene in which Gan Pilong misunderstood the noise of a construction site as a gunshot sound and suffered pain, and the way she protected Pilong's head with his cloak, will be remembered for a long time. In particular, I was impressed with the conversation between Pilong and Sang Sang right before the trauma occurred. Phil

This drama tells the story within the big frame of 'trauma', but on the other hand, there is another axis of 'healing'. 'Healing' is done through 'people', and characters playing the role of healers are placed here and there. First of all, the character that can be healed just by looking at it is Mrs. Kang Soon-deok. Although she plays the role of Juri's mother, she is actually close to everyone's mother. She is the mother of Kang Tae-tae's brother, Moon-young and Jae-su, and also the mother of Lee Sang-soo and Yoo Seung-jae. In the language of the state, it is "fake real mother." Consolation and wisdom are contained in unintentionally thrown words.

Jo Jae-su, who appears in the role of Kang-tae's friend, is a 'healing character'. Originally, he was one year older than Kang-tae, but he gladly became a friend for Kang-tae, who was struggling to take care of his older brother. Destiny respects, trusts, and waits for a friend no matter what choice he makes. Sometimes you give advice from a friend's point of view rather than your own. I think it showed the true friendship that people think of.

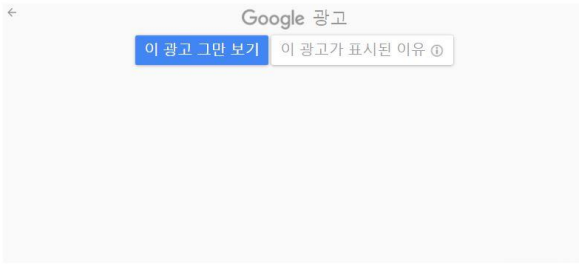

All of us living in the modern world suffer from mental illness to some extent, which conveys the message that this is not strange at all. I thought that the drama titled 'Psycho' was of course Go Go-Young, but on the contrary, Ko Ko-Young treats people in psychiatric hospitals as 'people' rather than 'patients'.

Moon-young did not perceive the patient as someone she had to help, but only looked at it from the other person's point of view. It seems that the drama wanted to convey the message that there is neither normal nor abnormal if you look at the world from the other person's point of view through Moonyoung's appearance.

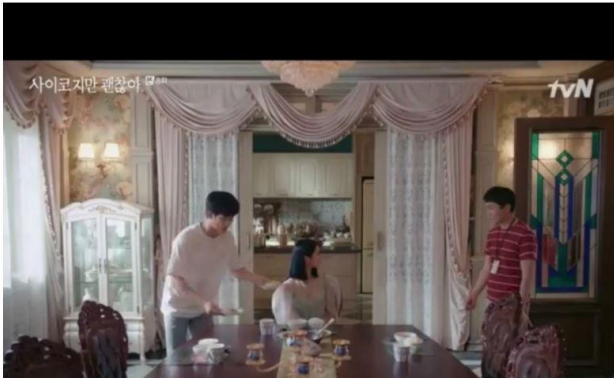

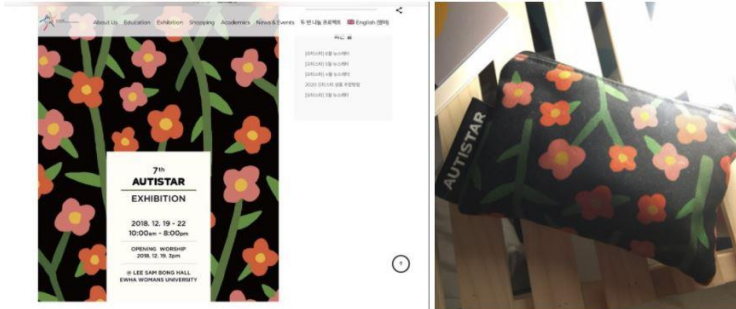

The more she tried to push her away, the more she was a magical source of sensibility that dominated the unconscious and an irresistible fascination for Kang-tae.

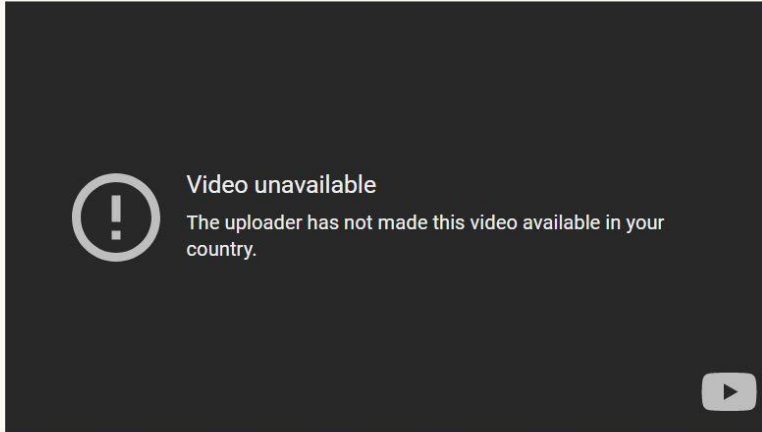

Moon Sang-tae (actor Oh Jung-se), who emerged as the hottest character in Psycho But It's Okay, performed well in the drama about high-functioning autism (HFA) and autism spectrum symptoms with a developmental disability level 3 in the play. Through the character Moon Sang-tae in the play, he is playing a big role in changing the perception of people with developmental disabilities.



It's Psycho But It's Okay In Episode 2, "The Little Red Shoe Lady," Sang-tae and Sang-tae arrive at the place where Go Go-young's fan signing event is held. While Kang-tae is away for a while, Sang-tae approaches a young child in a dinosaur suit and tries to show his intimacy. Because Moon Sang-tae usually likes the baby dinosaur Dooly, he knew the types of dinosaurs. It is a phenomenon that occurs due to the autistic tendency to be immersed in a specific one of the developmental disorders. However, parents with young children treat the condition as strange and resort to violence.

In an instant, the fan signing venue is in chaos, and his younger brother Kang-tae, who came to know this later, quickly takes off his jumper and covers his face. Here you can see the wisdom of the author. This is because the state with the autism spectrum along with developmental disabilities was protected through accurate research.

Autism spectrum or Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) is a symptom of Asperger's Syndrome and Savant's Syndrome in autism. It is an autistic disorder that is not accompanied by intellectual disability, constitute a pervasive developmental disability.

The state in the play is definitely good or bad. And I hate loud noises, touches, filth, violence and lies. Especially if you touch the back of the man's hair, it's a big deal. It is because the trauma of the scene where the mother was murdered occurred. As always, as a habit, he looks at his younger brother. This is because you can read the emotions of others by observing the minute facial expressions of others.

Psycho But It's Okay has a bunch of pretty decent people around it. People with developmental disabilities are recognized and accepted as they are. The people in the picture above are those characters. Oh Ji-Wang (actor Kim Chang-Wan), director of a decent hospital, a psychiatric hospital in the play, Kang Soon-Deok (actor Kim Mi-Kyung), the chef of a hospital restaurant and mother of Joo-Ri, who once had a crush on Kang-Tae, and Kang Tae-Ga's chicken delivery when she was a teenager wandering around the country with her older brother Kang Tae's friend Jo Jae-soo (actor Kang Ki-dong), a 7-year nurse at a decent psychiatric hospital, Nam Joo-ri (actor Park Gyu-young), who has had a crush on Kang-tae for a long time, and Ko Moon-young, a children's literature publisher who has been supporting him like a shadow for the past 10 years Sang Sang Sang Lee CEO Lee Sang (actor Kim Joo-heon) and Sang Sang Sang Sang Art Director Yoo Seung-jae (Park Jin-joo) are the people he meets directly or indirectly with Moon Sang Sang.

[Psycho But It's Okay](#) In Episode 8, [Beauty and the Beast](#) , there was a scene in which Go Go-young and Sang-tae had a fight over Mangtae, a doll that eats nightmares. This scene is the most noteworthy part of this drama . Strictly speaking, the status quo and Ko Mun-young are the relationship between the disabled and the non-disabled. Of course, they live together in the same house, but their relationship is between A and E. However, the author did not establish the relationship between Kom Young-yeong and Moon Sang-tae as the relationship between the disabled and the non-disabled. Even so, many Koreans live with mental problems. This is because mental health is a problem that anyone can experience, with one in four people suffering from it.

Moon Sang-tae, a developmentally disabled person, and Go Ko-young, who do not know love due to a congenital deficiency, see each other expressing their will on an equal footing. The two end up in a bloody fight over ownership of the nightmare-eating doll's cloak. The scene worth noting here is that Go Won-young never pulls on the top of the head under any circumstances. Instead, he's just holding on to his running shirt. ↑

They are considering developmental disabilities and the state of having the autism spectrum until the very end. Here, I was able to feel the very detailed sensibility of the writer and director.

It is a psychological drama depicting the process of three main characters, who are full of scarcity and scars, who are healed and grow with each other's warmth, but it is a luxury drama that gives the power to stand up again for many people living in a modern society where their self-esteem that is okay has collapsed. . In particular, I think this drama's great harvest is that it has made people aware of developmental disabilities that the public has not known well through the status of being loved as the hottest character.

As I was preparing for today's post, I decided to look for a movie that featured people with developmental disabilities as characters. Surprisingly, however, there were quite a few related films. Perhaps some of you have already seen it. For those of you who don't know about the related movie yet, I'll make an additional post.

Developmental disabilities refer to intellectual disabilities and autism spectrum disorders under the Welfare Act for Persons with Disabilities. Intellectual disability refers to a case where an IQ of 69 or less on a standardized intelligence test and comprehensive adaptive function do not satisfy the standards for individual independence and social responsibility. In the past, it was called mental retardation, but as the diagnosis system was recently revised, the name was changed to intellectual disability. Autism spectrum disorder is a developmental disorder characterized by impairments in verbal and nonverbal communication, qualitative impairment in social interaction, stereotyped behaviors, and limited interests. In the past, Asperger's Syndrome and Childhood Disintegrative Disorder were not classified as autistic disorders. We use the term autism spectrum disorder.

The cause of developmental disabilities is still unknown. The medical community is looking for a cure, but it is still an unknown world. You will see people with disabilities around you, like a psycho but okay. No, you will meet people with more severe disabilities than that.

As the corona virus swept the world, many people are living in pain. Among them, the disabled and their families who have to take care of them are probably the most difficult.

As an unfamiliar norm of social distancing arose, people with disabilities were placed in a situation with nowhere to go. This is because the facilities related to the disabled that can be used by the disabled, especially the representative welfare center for the disabled, have been closed. Although they have been slowly opening their doors recently, since last January until now, many people with disabilities have had nowhere to go.

When people with disabilities suffer, their families suffer the same. Because I have to take care of them all day at home. It is the UN's way to view about 10% of the people as disabled. Then, it is correct and reasonable to assume that there are 5 million disabled people in Korea.

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As the corona crisis continues, more and more families with disabilities are trying to make extreme choices. This is because no one is even interested in the disabled and their families, let alone economic difficulties.

One of the reasons why I had no choice but to watch Psycho But It's Okay was because of the lives of Sang-tae Moon and Kang-tae Moon. Kang-tae, who had to take care of his disabled older brother, heard the confession that he had never lived his life for a single day from the beginning, and Kang-tae's sorrow was conveyed to his heart.

This drama well explains why we need to change the way we look at people with disabilities. It shows how our very little kindness can reach them. I sincerely hope that our society's perceptions toward people with disabilities will be improved and changed through this drama.
